


See a doctor —

When to use virtual visits

- ▶ For non-emergency medical issues (especially as an alternative to the high cost of an emergency room or urgent care center)
- ▶ Your doctor or pediatrician is not available on your schedule
- ▶ You are traveling and need medical care
- ▶ You need a prescription
- ▶ When it's not convenient to leave your home or work
- ▶ Anytime, anywhere, including nights, weekends and even holidays

Virtual visits are covered as a primary care physician (PCP) visit as part of your medical plan for less than \$5.1 Register now so virtual visits are ready when you are!

Most virtual visits take 10 to 15 minutes. A doctor can write a prescription,² if needed, that you can pick up at your local pharmacy. All network doctors are aligned with the American Medical Association and Federation of State Medical Boards guidelines.

Choose

Click on *Choose a Provider* and select one of UnitedHealthcare's virtual visit provider groups: Amwell or Doctor on Demand.

Get care

- ▶ Register with your virtual provider group (may depend upon your location and the real-time availability of the virtual doctor)
- ▶ Enter a virtual waiting room
- ▶ Talk to a doctor³

Download the Amwell or Doctor on Demand apps from Google Play™ or the Apple® App Store® and access care that way anytime.

- Before deductible
- ¹ Virtual visits are based on a \$39 or \$40 charge for primary care visits. Virtual visits and convenience care clinics are covered at 90% before you meet your deductible. Urgent care and emergency room costs are covered at 80% after deductible. These are national averages and not based on a specific condition or treatment.
- ² Prescription services may not be available in all states. You are responsible for selecting an in-network pharmacy.
- ³ While virtual visits are available for psychology, nutrition counseling, maternity and other non-primary care services, they are not covered by your JPMC medical plan; you are responsible for the full cost of these services.



Remember: Your medical reimbursement account (MRA) funds can help offset out-of-pocket medical and prescription drug expenses, including virtual visit costs.
