## UnitedHealth Premium® Program



The UnitedHealth Premium<sup>®</sup> program provides physician designations based on quality and cost efficiency criteria to help members make more informed choices for their medical care. Physicians may also use these designations when referring patients to other physicians. The designations shown here include only the Premium Care Physician designation, which identifies physicians who meet both quality and cost efficiency criteria. The Premium Care Physician designation is intended only as a guide to choosing a physician and may be used as one of many factors you consider when choosing a physician. If you already have a physician, you may also wish to confer with him or her for advice on selecting other physicians. Physician evaluations have a risk of error and should not be the sole basis for selecting a physician. The fact that a physician does not have a Premium Care Physician designation does not mean that the physician does not provide quality health care services. All physicians in the UnitedHealthcare network have met certain minimum credentialing requirements (separate from the Premium program).
